Hi Michael.

Thank you for your e-mail.

Q- Is it possible write for me about all of your founds; size & dimensions, depth of your founds, deepest target and if no problem picture?

A- My device is exp 5000 and I had exp 4000 two months ago.

I fond twelve gold coins inside of stone. The depth was about 340cm.they had medium size. Also two weeks ago I found something that it used on wooden doors in Iran many years ago. It was 140cm underground.

Last week by exp 5000 I found one 22.28 Cm gold sheet with ancient cuneiform curved on it at 210 Cm depth. Weather was good and no snow was on ground.

I had a Rover C deluxe and found one shovel at 4m depth by it, but it is not a good device And operator mistakes influences results.

I even have found objects by Lectra search two times, the device that most people don't believe in. one object found in 1998 after I turned it on it pulled to a direction, I tracked and reached to a point with some white stones we paid attention it was a grave, after digging found a sword at 2-3 meters depth. second found: in 2001 I bought another Lectra .it was winter we went searching in an ancient graveyard, but it directed to a side we tracked it and reached to a small hill, we dug the point and found a silver bead among a small skeleton which was probably for a child.

I believe Lectra search has been the best device for me, although have found many objects by my EXPs, it has many accessories or implements whereas Lectra is cheap, very simple and with easy operation. If weather be good, Lectra works as best device.

Q- I want to know how often was you working by your Lectra that you only could detect 2 objects during 3 years?!!

A- at first I worked with it 3-4 months , but found nothing of course it was my fault that couldn't work well. I worked some while perhaps 1 month a year not much and after that it became damaged.

Q- Have you really found those gold objects only by exp series? especially the gold earrings. Were those single or a bunch of objects?

A-Yes, I really found them by exp series. It was single. It was 140cm underground. I did not use any metal detector.

Q- What was the alloy of objects? Were pure gold? had been formed any patina on surface? **A-** all were pure gold without any patina or even any color change, as soon as we touched, they showed real color of gold.

Q- Have you seen different answers from different sensors using your exp? Supersensor has better resolution.

Q-Why did you buy another new exp model? What was exp 4000 problems?

What can tell in comparison between Rover C and exps? I have heard all OKM products are basically the same.

A- In the exp 5000 ,it has 4vlf senders, they are more useful for finding metallic objects And high resolution, also it has GPS.

There is more differences between Rover and exp series.

Q-As you know I own Rover C with standard sensor and software, what's your opinion about preparing one supersensor + V3D for it? is it really useful and induce a different result?

A- I think, it is better that you change your device. Rover c is not a professional device.

Q- If we dig a hole over an supposed object. can again get the same graphic signal of that?

A- Yes, of course. I had the same with exp 4000 and it gave me the same result.

Q- Have you ever buried a test target that could detect by your exp?

A- No, I did not do it.

Q- What's your opinion about my sent file to you of unknown target?

A- I think you have to scan an area 4or 6 times from different angles.

If there is a real object, you will have the same result and the same scan without more difference in depth and scans. also, the kind of soil is more important. Please, keep north.

Q- Was software depth determination accurate and reliable?

A- Yes, in somewhat. for example the depth in my last measurement was 175cm but the real Depth was 140cm.

Q-Was software discrimination reliable?

A- Software can not discriminate between the kinds of metal. For this you can use of supersensor.

Q-If metal objects be placed in a hollow place underground (buried room or gut) that metals has no connection to ceiling, can exp detect it? have you had such experience?

A- I have not had the same experience, but I found a cave with exp 5000 without metal in 420cm

Q-Is it right that OKM products find only old buried target? Have you tried for fresh targets?

A- I don't know this and haven't tried for fresh gold.

Q- Is the size of object very important for detection by exp? I.e. is necessary to have 10 Cm x 10 Cm x 30 Cm dimension full of metal to be detected?

A- All of I discovered had small mass, but in exp systems you can distinguish every kind of anomaly in ground: metals, cavities, glasses, mud brick, human skeleton and other things.

Q- How effective is VLF sender on detecting anomalies in ground? What differences have you experienced between exp 4000 & 5000 in one same place?

A- Scans prepared with and without VLF sender had no significant differences; just the scans with VLFs had more lucidity. VLF helps to better metal detection.

Exp 4000 & 5000 gave similar results, but in 5000 metal detecting is better.

BTW; recently I bought one Lorenze deepmax and one Emfad UG12 just wait by spring to see what 's their special abilities
